Procedural

1. Call to Order at 7:31pm

- 2. Roll Call Alan Jasperson, John Vyvyan, Russell Weis, Greg Foat and Matthew Rowntree.
- 3. Pledge of Allegiance suspended
- 4. Approval of Agenda
 - a. Motion to approve the Agenda made by Russell Weis and seconded by Matthew Rowntree. The motion carried unanimously.

Farm #4/Eagle Creek

- 5. Discuss and consider the proposed assessment cost estimates to determine the amount and term of the post-annexation assessment.
 - a. Nielsen, Madsen & Barber started the estimate in 2019 and the numbers have not changed much.
 - b. There are still meetings, mailings, objections, etc. related to the assessment to consider that need to be included in the estimate.
 - c. The proposed assessment is \$750,000.00 over a five-year term.
 - d. Minimum charge for the lowest assessed benefits is \$318.02 or \$63.60/year over 5 years.
 - e. \$36.32/acre for the whole assessment
 - f. The Sewer District will still contribute their 6.23% which amounts to \$46,715.
 - g. The board discussed the bank repairs needed and factored that into the decision for the assessment.
 - i. Bank repairs
 - ii. Spraying to prevent over growth as it is cheaper than de-brushing
 - iii. Dredging
 - iv. There are no tile repairs or replacements included in the estimate provided by Nielsen, Madsen & Barber.
- 6. Discuss and consider the Summary Report of Nielsen, Madsen & Barber as to the benefits.

- a. Motion by Matthew Rowntree to assess the Farm #4/Eagle Creek Farm Drainage District \$750,000.00 over a 5-year term and seconded by John Vyvyan. The motion passed unanimously.
- 7. Discuss and consider the further procedures relative to the assessment process, including the public hearing on September 14, 2021, and notices to the landowners of the same.
 - a. Sending out notices to landowners and notice of hearing on September 14th, how to submit objections, etc.
 - b. Send out contact sheet to all landowners for the members of the board and expectations surrounding district requirements for the ditches.
 - c. Assessment will be recorded in mid-late October.
 - d. The Annexation was approved by the State, Racine County, and the WI Court of Appeals.
- 8. Have been communicating with the County regarding the USGS sites.
 - a. Add to agenda and who will pay?
- 9. Updates on the bank spraying status. add to agenda
- 10. Five-mile road near Alan's house, there are dams in water, it needs to be dredged, and a tree needs to be removed.
