

**LEGAL NOTICE
COMBINED HEARING ON ASSESSMENT OF BENEFITS
AND PROPOSED ASSESSMENT OF COSTS**

**TO: All Members of the Farm #5/Hoosier Creek Drainage District
Located in Racine and Kenosha Counties, Wisconsin**

You are hereby notified that a meeting of the Racine County Board of Drainage Commissioners will be held on **August 25, 2026, at 7:00 p.m.**, in the auditorium at the Racine County Building, Ives Grove Complex, located at 14200 Washington Avenue, Sturtevant, Wisconsin 53177, in order to conduct a hearing pursuant to Wis. Stat. Ch. 88 and potentially order an Assessment as stated herein.

The meeting is based upon a report which has been filed by the Racine County Board of Drainage Commissioners showing the assessed benefits and proposed assessment of costs for maintenance, repairs and normal operating expenses, in the amount of \$750,000.00 to members of the Farm #5/Hoosier Creek Drainage District. A copy of said report and map is available for inspection at the office of the Racine County Treasurer and on our website (www.racinecountydratione.com). However, the Racine County Treasurer will not give information over the telephone regarding said report.

The purpose of the meeting is to:

1. Allow property owners within the Farm #5/Hoosier Creek Drainage District to examine their assessed benefits, the proposed assessment of costs, to enter comment thereon, and to address all general concerns of the people residing in the district;
2. Review and confirm assessed benefits;
3. Review and confirm the extent of any repairs, maintenance, restoration, administrative and other expenses associated with the Farm #5/Hoosier Creek Drainage District drainways, and assess costs for maintenance, repairs and normal operating expenses in the amount of \$750,000.00; and
4. Review and confirm the allocation among all of the parcels of land in the Farm #5/Hoosier Creek Drainage District that receive benefit based upon the confirmed benefits.

All objections to the jurisdiction of the Drainage Board, the sufficiency or legality of any condition report, or assessment of benefits, assessment of costs, or the equity of any assessment, shall be filed with the Drainage Board, in writing, before the hearing and said objections shall be set forth clearly and in detail.
