PUBLIC HEARING ON PRO-  
POSED ASSESSMENT OF BENE-  
FITS AND PROPOSED ASSES-  
SMENT OF COSTS**

**TO: The Village of Union Grove  
Racine County, Wisconsin**

You are hereby notified that a hearing of the Racine County Board of Drainage Commissioners will be held on **Tuesday, June 9, 2026, at 5 :00 pm**, in the auditorium at the Racine County Building, Ives Grove Complex, located at 14200 Washington Avenue, Sturtevant, Wisconsin 53177.

The hearing is to consider an assessment of the Village of Union Grove per Wis. Stat. § 88.64, based on a report from professional engineers considering the items reflected in Wis. Stat. § 88.64(3)(a)-(e). The proposed assessment is for maintenance and associated costs contemplated by Wis. Stat. § 88.64 in the amount of \$2,087,485.00, payable in two annual installments (2027-2028).

A copy of said report is available for inspection by all interested persons at the office of the Racine County Treasurer located at 730 Wisconsin Ave, Racine, WI 53403. The report can also be viewed on the Racine County Board of Drainage Commissioners website at: [www.racine-countydrainage.com](http://www.racine-countydrainage.com).

The purpose of the hearing is to:

1. Present the Engineer's Report on the proposed assessment;
2. Hear all objections to the report by any aggrieved person;
3. Allow Village of Union Grove representatives if they choose to introduce evidence that tends to establish a different allocation of costs;
4. Allow public comment on the proposed assessment;
5. Consider, and, potentially issue, an Order directing the Village of Union Grove to pay the assessment amount of \$2,087,485.000, payable in 2 annual installments (2027-2028), pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 88.64.

All objections to the jurisdiction of the Drainage Board, the sufficiency or legality of the subject report, assessment of costs, or the equity of the assessment, shall be filed with the Racine County Board of Drainage Commissioners, in writing, before the hearing and said objections shall be set forth clearly and in detail.
